

## **MIND RENEWED 11-27-11 VIDEO Prison no more pt 1**

**RENEW**-The act of giving spiritual life to an individual by **bringing them back to the original starting point** or what was always intended from above.

Rom 8:29 God knew what he was doing from the very beginning. He decided from the outset to **shape the lives of those who love him along the same lines as the life of his Son**. The Son stands first in the line of humanity he restored. **We see the original and intended shape of our lives there in him.** MSG

Isa 55:8 "**I don't think the way you think**. The way you work isn't the way I work." God's Decree.

9 "For as the sky soars high above earth, so the way I work surpasses the way you work, and **the way I think is beyond the way you think**. MSG

Ps 51:10 Create in me a clean heart, O God, and **renew a right, persevering, and steadfast spirit within me**. AMP

**EAGEL STORY** Great was the excitement amongst the Conservation people when the big wooden crate wherein the eagle was transported, arrived at the Canyon. They opened the cage door and held their breath, but sadly the Eagle would not fly. **It was one thing to get the bird out of the cage, but how does one get the cage out of the bird?** After many frustrating hours, they suddenly heard the call of another Black Eagle! Immediately the once captive bird looked up and seconds later took off and started circling with the other eagle!

Isa 40:31 But those who wait for the Lord [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] shall change and renew their strength and power; they shall lift their wings and mount up **[close to God] as eagles [mount up to the sun]; they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint or become tired**. AMP

Isa 40:31 But those who wait upon **God get fresh strength. They spread their wings and soar like eagles. They run and don't get tired**, they walk and don't lag behind.

Rom 12:2 Do not be conformed to this world (this age), [fashioned after and adapted to its external, superficial customs], but **be transformed (changed) by the [entire] renewal of your mind [by its new ideals and its new attitude], so that you may prove [for yourselves] what is the good and acceptable and perfect will of God**, even the thing which is good and acceptable and perfect [in His sight for you]. AMP ⇕⇕⇕

Rom 12:2 Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, **fix your attention on God. You'll be changed from the inside out.** Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it. Unlike the culture around you, always dragging you down to its level of immaturity, God brings the best out of you, develops well-formed maturity in you. MSG

Eph 4:23 And be **constantly renewed in the spirit of your mind** [having a fresh mental and spiritual attitude], AMP

Eph 4:23 a life renewed **from the inside** MSG

1 Cor 2:16 For who has known or understood the mind (the counsels and purposes) of the Lord so as to guide and instruct Him and give Him knowledge? But **we have the mind of Christ (the Messiah) and do hold the thoughts (feelings and purposes) of His heart.** AMP

1 Cor 2:16 Isaiah's question, "Is there anyone around who knows God's Spirit, anyone who knows what he is doing?" has been answered: **Christ knows, and we have Christ's Spirit.** MSG

1 Peter 4:1 SO, SINCE Christ suffered in the flesh for us, for you, arm yourselves with **the same thought and purpose [patiently to suffer rather than fail to please God].** For whoever has suffered in the flesh **[having the mind of Christ] is done with [intentional] sin [has stopped pleasing himself and the world, and pleases God],**

1 Cor 2:11 **Who ever knows what you're thinking and planning except you yourself? The same with God — except that he not only knows what he's thinking,**

12 **but he lets us in on it. God offers a full report on the gifts of life and salvation that he is giving us.**

13 We don't have to rely on the world's guesses and opinions. We didn't learn this by reading books or going to school; we learned it from God, **who taught us person-to-person through Jesus, and we're passing it on to you in the same firsthand, personal way.** MSG

Prov 16:3 Roll your works upon the Lord [commit and trust them wholly to Him; He will **cause your thoughts to become agreeable to His will, and] so shall your plans be established and succeed.** AMP

Ezek 11:19 I'll give **you a new heart. I'll put a new spirit in you.** I'll cut out your stone heart and replace it with a red-blooded, firm-muscled heart.

Ezek 18:31 Clean house. No more rebellions, please. **Get a new heart! Get a new spirit!** Why would you choose to die, Israel?

32 I take no pleasure in anyone's death. Decree of God, the Master. "Make a clean break! Live!" MSG

2 Cor 5:17 Therefore **if any person is [ingrafted] in Christ (the Messiah) he is a new creation (a new creature altogether)**; the old [previous moral and spiritual condition] has passed away. Behold, the **fresh and new has come!** AMP

**A Capterpillar is transformed into a butterfly—We as new creatures have the ability to think like Christ does--- New DNA has made the way for new thinking.**

1 Peter 4:1 SO, SINCE Christ suffered in the flesh for us, for you, arm yourselves with the same thought and purpose [patiently to suffer rather than fail to please God]. For whoever has **suffered in the flesh [having the mind of Christ] is done with [intentional] sin [has stopped pleasing himself and the world, and pleases God],**

2 So that he can no longer spend the rest of his natural life living by [his] human appetites and desires, but [he lives] for what God wills. AMP

1 Peter 4:1 Since Jesus went through **everything you're going through and more, learn to think like him. Think of your sufferings as a weaning from that old sinful habit of always expecting to get your own way.**

2 Then you'll be able to **live out your days free to pursue what God wants instead of being tyrannized by what you want.** MSG

Col 3:11 **[In this new creation all distinctions vanish.] There is no room for and there can be neither Greek nor Jew,** circumcised nor uncircumcised, [nor difference between nations whether alien] barbarians or Scythians [who are the most savage of all], nor slave or free man; but Christ is all and in all [everything and everywhere, to all men, without distinction of person]. AMP

Phil 2:5 **Think of yourselves the way Christ Jesus thought of himself.** MSG

Phil 3:14 I press on toward the goal to win the [supreme and heavenly] **prize to which God in Christ Jesus is calling us upward.**

15 So let those [of us] who are **spiritually mature and full-grown have this mind and hold these convictions;** and if in any respect you have a different attitude of mind, God will make that clear to you also. AMP

2 Tim 1:7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but **[He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.** AMP

1 Peter 5:8 Be **well balanced (temperate, sober of mind), be vigilant and cautious at all times;** for that enemy of yours, the devil, roams around like a lion roaring [in fierce hunger], seeking someone to seize upon and devour. AMP

Phil 4:8 For the rest, brethren, whatever is true, **whatever is worthy of reverence and is honorable and seemly, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely and lovable, whatever is kind and winsome and gracious, if there is any virtue and excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think on and weigh** and take account of these things [fix your minds on them]. AMP ↕↕↕

Phil 4:8 Summing it all up, friends, **I'd say you'll do best by filling your minds and meditating on things true, noble, reputable, authentic, compelling, gracious** — the best, not the worst; the beautiful, not the ugly; things to praise, not things to curse. MSG

**Our thinking must change in line with who we are.**

2 Tim 2:7 **Think over these things I am saying [understand them and grasp their application]**, for the Lord will grant you full insight and understanding in everything.

2 Tim 2:7 **Think it over.** God will make it all plain. MSG

Prov 23:7 **For as he thinks in his heart, so is he.** As one who reckons, he says to you, eat and drink, yet his heart is not with you [but is grudging the cost]. AMP

Isa 54:2 "Clear lots of ground for your tents! Make your tents large. Spread out! **Think big!** Use plenty of rope, drive the tent pegs deep. MSG

Rom 5:10 If, when we were at our worst, we were put on friendly terms with God by the sacrificial death of his Son, now that we're at our best, **just think of how our lives will expand and deepen by means of his resurrection life!** MSG

Rom 5:15 Yet the rescuing gift is not exactly parallel to the death-dealing sin. If one man's sin put crowds of people at the dead-end abyss of separation from God, **just think what God's gift poured through one man, Jesus Christ, will do!** MSG

Rom 6:3 That's what baptism into the life of Jesus means.

4 When we are lowered into the water, it is like the burial of Jesus; when we are raised up out of the water, it is like the resurrection of Jesus.

5 Each of us is raised into a light-filled world by our Father so that we can see where we're going in our new grace-sovereign country.

6-7 Could it be any clearer? **Our old way of life was nailed to the Cross with Christ, a decisive end to that sin-miserable life — no longer at sin's every beck and call!**

What we believe is this:

8 If we get included in Christ's sin-conquering death, we also get included in his life-saving resurrection.

9 We know that when Jesus was raised from the dead it was a signal of the end of death-as-the-end. Never again will death have the last word.

10 When Jesus died, he took sin down with him, but alive he brings God down to us.

11 From now on, think of it this way: Sin speaks a dead language that means nothing to you; **God speaks your mother tongue, and you hang on every word. You are dead to sin and alive to God. That's what Jesus did.** MSG

Rom 8:31 So, **what do you think? With God on our side like this, how can we lose?** MSG

1 Cor 1:7 **Just think — you don't need a thing, you've got it all!** All God's gifts are right in front of you as you wait expectantly for our Master Jesus to arrive on the scene for the Finale. MSG

1 Cor 15:34 **Think straight. Awaken to the holiness of life.** No more playing fast and loose with resurrection facts. Ignorance of God is a luxury you can't afford in times like these. Aren't you embarrassed that you've let this kind of thing go on as long as you have? MSG

2 Cor 13:11 And that's about it, friends. Be cheerful. Keep things in good repair. Keep your spirits up. **Think in harmony. Be agreeable. Do all that, and the God of love and peace will be with you for sure.** MSG

Eph 4:5 You have one Master, one faith, one baptism,  
6 one God and Father of all, who rules over all, works through all, and is present in all. **Everything you are and think and do is permeated with Oneness.** MSG

Col 2:13 When you were stuck in your old sin-dead life, you were incapable of responding to God. God brought you alive — right along with Christ! **Think of it! All sins forgiven,** MSG

Heb 9:14 **think how much more the blood of Christ cleans up our whole lives,** inside and out. MSG

Rom 8:6 Now **the mind of the flesh** [which is sense and reason without the Holy Spirit] is death [death that comprises all the miseries arising from sin, both here and hereafter]. **But the mind of the [Holy] Spirit is life and [soul] peace [both now and forever].**

7 [That is] **because the mind of the flesh [with its carnal thoughts and purposes] is hostile** to God, for it does not submit itself to God's Law; indeed it cannot.

8 So then those who are living the life of the flesh [catering to the appetites and impulses of their carnal nature] cannot please or satisfy God, or be acceptable to Him.

9 But you are not living the life of the flesh, **you are living the life of the Spirit,** if the [Holy] Spirit of God [really] dwells within you [directs and controls you]. But if anyone does not possess the [Holy] Spirit of Christ, he is none of His [he does not belong to Christ, is not truly a child of God]. AMP

Rom 8:6 Obsession with self in these matters is a dead end; attention to God leads us out into the open, into a spacious, free life.

7 **Focusing on the self is the opposite of focusing on God.** Anyone completely absorbed in self ignores God, ends up thinking more about self than God. That person ignores who God is and what he is doing.

8 And God isn't pleased at being ignored.

9 But if **God himself has taken up residence in your life, you can hardly be thinking more of yourself than of him.** Anyone, of course, who has not welcomed this invisible but clearly present God, the Spirit of Christ, won't know what we're talking about.

Prov 14:30 A calm **and undisturbed mind and heart are the life and health of the body**, but envy, jealousy, and wrath are like rottenness of the bones. AMP

Prov 14:30 A **sound mind makes for a robust body**, but runaway emotions corrode the bones. MSG

Prov 15:15 All the days of the desponding and afflicted **are made evil [by anxious thoughts and forebodings], but he who has a glad heart has a continual feast [regardless of circumstances]**. AMP

Prov 12:5 **The thoughts and purposes of the [consistently] righteous are honest and reliable**, but the counsels and designs of the wicked are treacherous. AMP

Prov 21:5 The **thoughts of the [steadily] diligent tend only to plenteousness**, but everyone who is impatient and hasty hastens only to want.

2 Tim 3:16 **Every Scripture** is God-breathed (given by His inspiration) and profitable for instruction, for reproof and conviction of sin, for correction of error and discipline in obedience, [and] for **training in righteousness (in holy living, in conformity to God's will in thought, purpose, and action)**,

Heb 10:16 This is the agreement (testament, covenant) that I will set up and conclude with them after those days, says the Lord: **I will imprint My laws upon their hearts, and I will inscribe them on their minds (on their inmost thoughts and understanding)**, AMP

2 Cor 10:3 For though we walk (live) in the flesh, we are not carrying on our warfare according to the flesh and using mere human weapons.

4 For the weapons of our warfare are not physical [weapons of flesh and blood], but they are mighty before God for the **overthrow and destruction of strongholds**,

5 [Inasmuch as we] refute arguments and theories **and reasonings and every proud and lofty thing that sets itself up against the [true] knowledge of God**; and we **lead every thought and purpose away captive** into the obedience of Christ (the Messiah, the Anointed one),

1 Peter 1:13 **Wherefore gird up the loins of your mind**, be sober, and hope to the end for the grace that is to be brought unto you at the revelation of Jesus Christ; **Loins- area of reproduction** **VIDEO EAGEL SONG**
