

NO FEAR 10-31-11 VIDEO FEAR

Halloween- scary, most of us know there are no monsters etc sometimes we fear change, rejection, abandonment, death etc. We must see that which we fear has been hunted down God.

FEAR- (phobas) that which is being scared causes us to to flee (flight)

The answer for fear is not necessarily running away (not facing) but standing in its face.

Ps 44:6 For **I will not trust in and lean on my bow, neither shall my sword save me.**

7 But **You have saved us from our foes** and have put them to shame who hate us.

8 In God **we have made our boast all the day long**, and we will give thanks to Your name forever. Selah [pause, and calmly think of that]! AMP

Ps 91:5 Fear nothing — not wild wolves in the night, not flying arrows in the day,

6 **Not disease that prowls through the darkness, not disaster that erupts at high noon.**

7 Even though others succumb all around, drop like flies right and left, **no harm will even graze you.**

8 You'll stand untouched, watch it all from a distance, watch the wicked turn into corpses.

9 Yes, **because GOD's your refuge, the High God your very own home,**

10 Evil can't get close to you, harm can't get through the door. MSG

Ps 60:11 O **give us help against the adversary**, for vain (ineffectual and to no purpose) is the help or salvation of man.

12 Through God **we shall do valiantly, for He it is Who shall tread down our adversaries.** AMP

Isa 8:11 For the Lord spoke thus to me with His strong hand [upon me], and warned and instructed me not to walk in the way of this people, saying,

12 Do not call conspiracy [or hard, or holy] all that this people will call conspiracy [or hard, or holy]; **neither be in fear of what they fear, nor [make others afraid and] in dread.**

13 The Lord of hosts — **regard Him as holy and honor His holy name [by regarding Him as your only hope of safety]**, and let Him be your fear and let Him be your dread **[lest you offend Him by your fear of man and distrust of Him].**

14 And **He shall be a sanctuary [a sacred and indestructible asylum to those who reverently fear and trust in Him]**; but He shall be a Stone of stumbling and a Rock of offense to both the houses of Israel, a trap and a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

Isa 8:11 God spoke strongly to me, grabbed me with both hands and **warned me not to go along with this people.** He said:

12 **"Don't be like this people, always afraid somebody is plotting against them. Don't fear what they fear. Don't take on their worries.**

13 If you're going to worry, worry about The Holy. Fear God-of-the-Angel-Armies.

14 **The Holy can be either a Hiding Place or a Boulder blocking** your way, The Rock standing in the willful way of both houses of Israel, A barbed-wire Fence preventing trespass to the citizens of Jerusalem. MSG

Matt 10:28 "**Don't be bluffed into silence by the threats of bullies.** There's nothing they can do to **your soul, your core being.** Save your fear for God, **who holds your entire life — body and soul — in his hands.** MSG

Ps 34:7 The **Angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear Him** [who revere and worship Him with awe] and each of them He delivers. AMP

Ps 34:7 **God's angel sets up a circle of protection around us** while we pray. MSG

Ps 23:4 Even when the way goes through Death Valley, **I'm not afraid when you walk at my side.** Your trusty shepherd's crook makes me feel secure.

5 **You serve me a six-course dinner right in front of my enemies.** You revive my drooping head; **my cup brims with blessing.** MSG

Eph 6:10 And that about wraps it up. **God is strong, and he wants you strong.**

11 So take **everything the Master has set out for you,** well-made weapons of the best materials. And put them to use so **you will be able to stand up to everything the Devil throws your way.**

12 This is no afternoon athletic contest that we'll walk away from and forget about in a couple of hours. This is for keeps, **a life-or-death fight to the finish against the Devil and all his angels.**

13 Be prepared. You're up against far more than you can handle on your own. **Take all the help you can get, every weapon God has issued,** so that when it's all over but the shouting you'll still be on your feet.

14 Truth, righteousness,

15 peace,

16 faith,

17 and salvation are more than words. **Learn how to apply them. You'll need them throughout your life.** God's **Word is an indispensable weapon.**

18 In the same way, **prayer is essential in this ongoing warfare.** Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out. MSG

1 John 4:4 Little children, **you are of God [you belong to Him] and have [already] defeated and overcome them** [the agents of the antichrist], because **He Who lives in you is greater (mightier) than he who is in the world.** AMP

Prov 3:25 **No need to panic over alarms or surprises, or predictions that doomsday's just around the corner,**

26 Because GOD will be right there with you; he'll keep you safe and sound.

1 John 4:18 There is **no fear in love [dread does not exist], but full-grown (complete, perfect) love turns fear out of doors and expels every trace of terror! For fear brings with it the thought of punishment, and [so] he who is afraid has not reached the full maturity of love** [is not yet grown into love's complete perfection].

1 John 4:18 There is **no room in love for fear. Well-formed love banishes fear. Since fear is crippling, a fearful life — fear of death, fear of judgment — is one not yet fully formed in love.** MSG

Rom 8:15 This resurrection life you received from God is **not a timid, grave-tending life. It's adventurously expectant, greeting God with a childlike "What's next, Papa?"** MSG

2 Tim 1:7 For **God did not give us a spirit of timidity (of cowardice, of craven and cringing and fawning fear), but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of calm and well-balanced mind and discipline and self-control.** AMP

STORM WHILE JESUS SLEPT Matt 8:26 And He said to them, **Why are you timid and afraid, O you of little faith? Then He got up and rebuked the winds** and the sea, and there was a great and wonderful calm (a perfect peaceableness). AMP

John 14:27 **Peace I leave with you; My [own] peace I now give and bequeath to you.** Not as the world gives do I give to you. **Do not let your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid. [Stop allowing yourselves to be agitated and disturbed; and do not permit yourselves to be fearful and intimidated and cowardly and unsettled.]**

28 You heard Me tell you, I am going away and I am coming [back] to you. If you [really] loved Me, **you would have been glad, because I am going to the Father; for the Father is greater and mightier than I am.**

29 And now I have told you [this] before it occurs, **so that when it does take place you may believe and have faith in and rely on Me.**

30 I will not talk with you much more, for the prince (evil genius, ruler) of the world is coming. **And he has no claim on Me. [He has nothing in common with Me; there is nothing in Me that belongs to him, and he has no power over Me.]** AMP

John 14:27 I'm **leaving you well and whole. That's my parting gift to you. Peace.** I don't leave you the way **you're used to being left — feeling abandoned, bereft. So don't be upset. Don't be distraught.**

28 "You've heard me tell you, 'I'm going away, and I'm coming back.' If you loved me, **you would be glad that I'm on my way to the Father because the Father is the goal and purpose of my life.**

29 "I've told you this ahead of time, before it happens, so that when it does happen, **the confirmation will deepen your belief in me.**

30 I'll not be talking with you much more like this because the chief of this godless world is about to attack. **But don't worry — he has nothing on me, no claim on me.** MSG

1 Chron 28:20 David continued to address Solomon: **"Take charge! Take heart! Don't be anxious or get discouraged. God, my God, is with you in this;** he won't walk off and leave you in the lurch. He's at your side until every last detail is completed for conducting the worship of God. MSG **VIDEO FEAR NOT**

Job was sure there were "monsters under his bed." Fear and dread work together. Dread is expectancy of something fearful or horrible or painful.

Job 3:25 For the thing which **I greatly fear comes upon me,** and that of which I am afraid befalls me.

26 I was not or am not at ease, nor had I or have I rest, nor was I or am I quiet, yet **trouble came and still comes [upon me].** AMP

Job 3:25 The **worst of my fears has come true, what I've dreaded most has happened.**

26 My repose is shattered, my peace destroyed. No rest for me, ever — death has invaded life." MSG

Job 4:14 **Dread stared me in the face, and Terror.** I was scared to death — I shook from head to foot.

15 A spirit glided right in front of me — the hair on my head stood on end.

16 I couldn't tell what it was that appeared there — a blur . . . and then I heard a muffled voice: MSG

Job 5:20 **In famine He will redeem you from death,** and in war from the power of the sword.

21 You shall be **hidden from the scourge of the tongue,** neither shall you be afraid of destruction when it comes.

22 At **destruction and famine you shall laugh,** neither shall you be afraid of the living creatures of the earth. AMP

Job 42:10 And the **Lord turned the captivity of Job and restored his fortunes, when he prayed for his friends;** also the Lord gave Job twice as much as he had before. AMP

Ps 27:1 Light, space, zest — that's God! **So, with him on my side I'm fearless, afraid of no one and nothing.**

2 When vandal hordes ride down ready to eat me alive, Those bullies and toughs fall flat on their faces.

3 **When besieged, I'm calm as a baby. When all hell breaks loose, I'm collected and cool.** MSG

Ps 46:2 **Therefore we will not fear, though the earth should change and though the mountains be shaken into the midst of the seas,**

3 Though its waters roar and foam, though the mountains tremble at its swelling and tumult. Selah [pause, and calmly think of that]! AMP

Ps 46:2 We **stand fearless at the cliff-edge of doom, courageous in seastorm and earthquake,**

3 Before the rush and roar of oceans, the tremors that shift mountains. **Jacob-wrestling God fights for us, God of angel armies protects us.** MSG

Ps 56:4 **By [the help of] God I will praise His word; on God** I lean, rely, and confidently put my trust; I will not fear. **What can man, who is flesh, do to me?** AMP

Ps 56:4 I'm **proud to praise God; fearless now,** I trust in God. What can mere mortals do? MSG

Isa 41:10 **Fear not [there is nothing to fear], for I am with you; do not look around you in terror and be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen and harden you to difficulties,** yes, I will help you; yes, I will hold you up and retain you with My [victorious] right hand of rightness and justice. AMP

Isa 41:10 Don't panic. **I'm with you. There's no need to fear for I'm your God. I'll give you strength. I'll help you. I'll hold you steady,** keep a firm grip on you. MSG

Isa 41:13 For I the Lord your God hold your right hand; **I am the Lord, Who says to you, Fear not; I will help you!** AMP

Isa 41:13 That's right. Because I, your God, have a firm grip on you and I'm not letting go. I'm telling you, **'Don't panic. I'm right here to help you.'** MSG

Isa 43:1 But now, GOD's Message, the God who made you in the first place, Jacob, the One who got you started, Israel: **"Don't be afraid, I've redeemed you. I've called your name. You're mine.**

2 When you're in over your head, **I'll be there with you.** When you're in rough waters, **you will not go down.** When you're between a rock and a hard place, it won't be a dead end —

3 Because I am GOD, **your personal God,** The Holy of Israel, your Savior. **I paid a huge price for you:** all of Egypt, with rich Cush and Seba thrown in!

4 That's how much you mean to me! **That's how much I love you!** I'd sell off the whole world to get you back, **trade the creation just for you.** MSG

Isa 44:8 **Fear not, nor be afraid [in the coming violent upheavals];** have I not told it to you from of old and declared it? And you are My witnesses! Is there a God besides Me? There is no [other] Rock; I know not any. AMP

Matt 10:31 So **don't be intimidated by all this bully talk.** You're worth more than a million canaries. MSG

2 Cor 4:1 Since **God has so generously let us in on what he is doing, we're not about to throw up our hands and walk off the job** just because we run into occasional hard times. MSG

Heb 10:38 But the just shall live by faith [My righteous servant shall live by his conviction respecting man's relationship to God and divine things, and holy fervor born of faith and conjoined with it]; and **if he draws back and shrinks in fear, My soul has no delight or pleasure in him.** AMP

IN A STORM Matt 14:27 But instantly He spoke to them, saying, **Take courage! I AM!** Stop being afraid! AMP

Phil 1:28 **And do not [for a moment] be frightened or intimidated** in anything by your opponents and adversaries, for such [constancy and fearlessness] will be a clear sign (proof and seal) to them of [their impending] destruction, but [a sure token and evidence] of your deliverance and salvation, and that from God.
